## *“Apollo Amazer 3G Maxx shows best performance on dry roads,” states ADAC summer tyre test*

### *“A new star in the horizon,” says Auto Bild, Germany*

Two top-rung German magazines of immense repute on tyre testing, gave high billing to Apollo Tyres in their most recent tests conducted with brands currently available in the German market. The high ranking and superior performance on wet, dry and braking tests, come as a testimony to the products on offer.
