Adjust the mirrors to your comfort before you start



the window and then adjust the mirror. So basically you see less of your car and the blind spot is taken care off.

Follow these tips so that by just looking over you will determine traffic behind and to the right of you. If your car comes with a left side ORVM,

life easier. When positioning the ORVM, remember that you don't need to see the side of your car in the reflection. So adjust it slightly wider so that you see most of the road. Try to minimize the overlap of view in the mirror

inside and the ORVM so that you can avoid blind spots.
